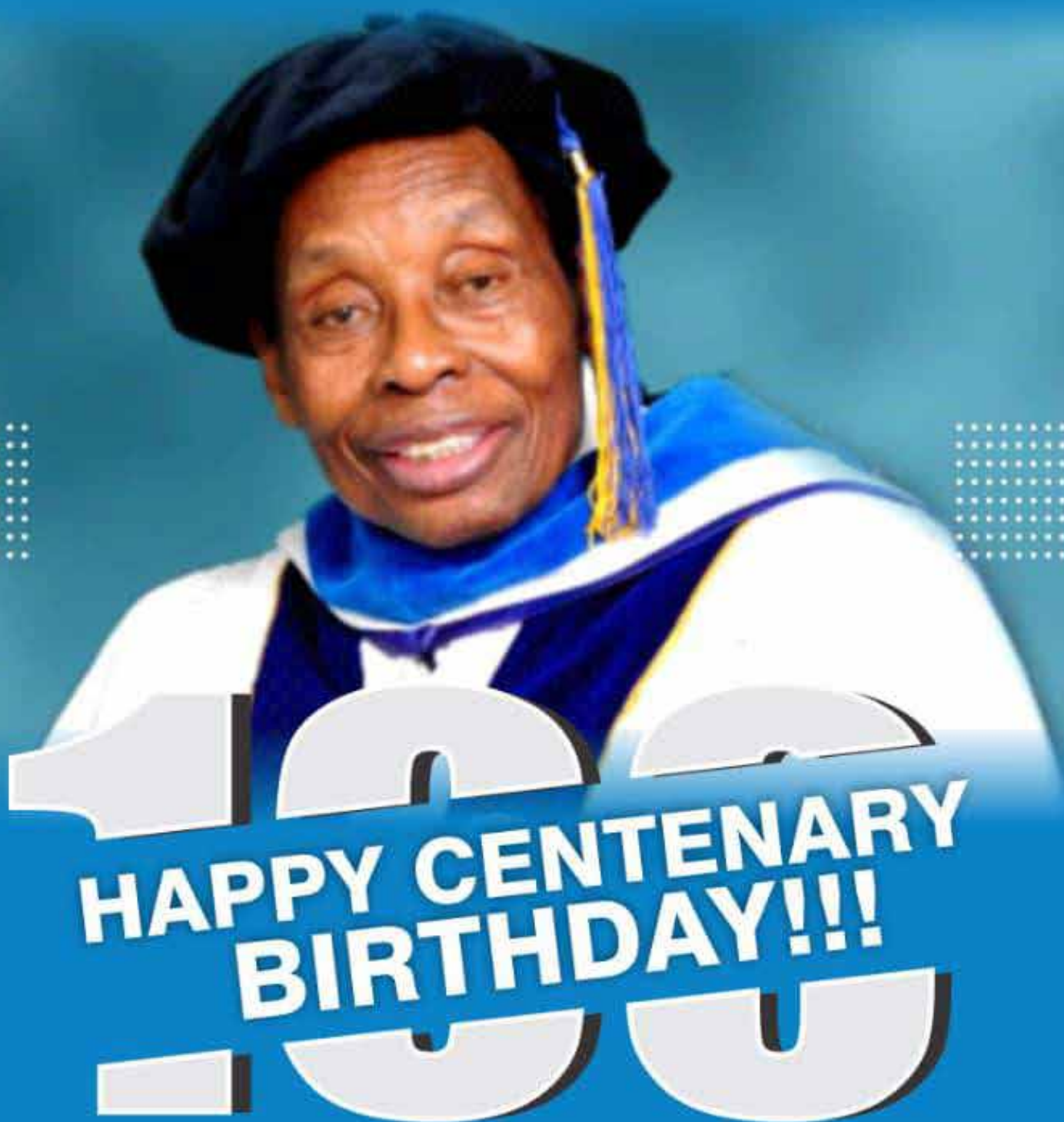

ZEGU represented at continental cyber security training

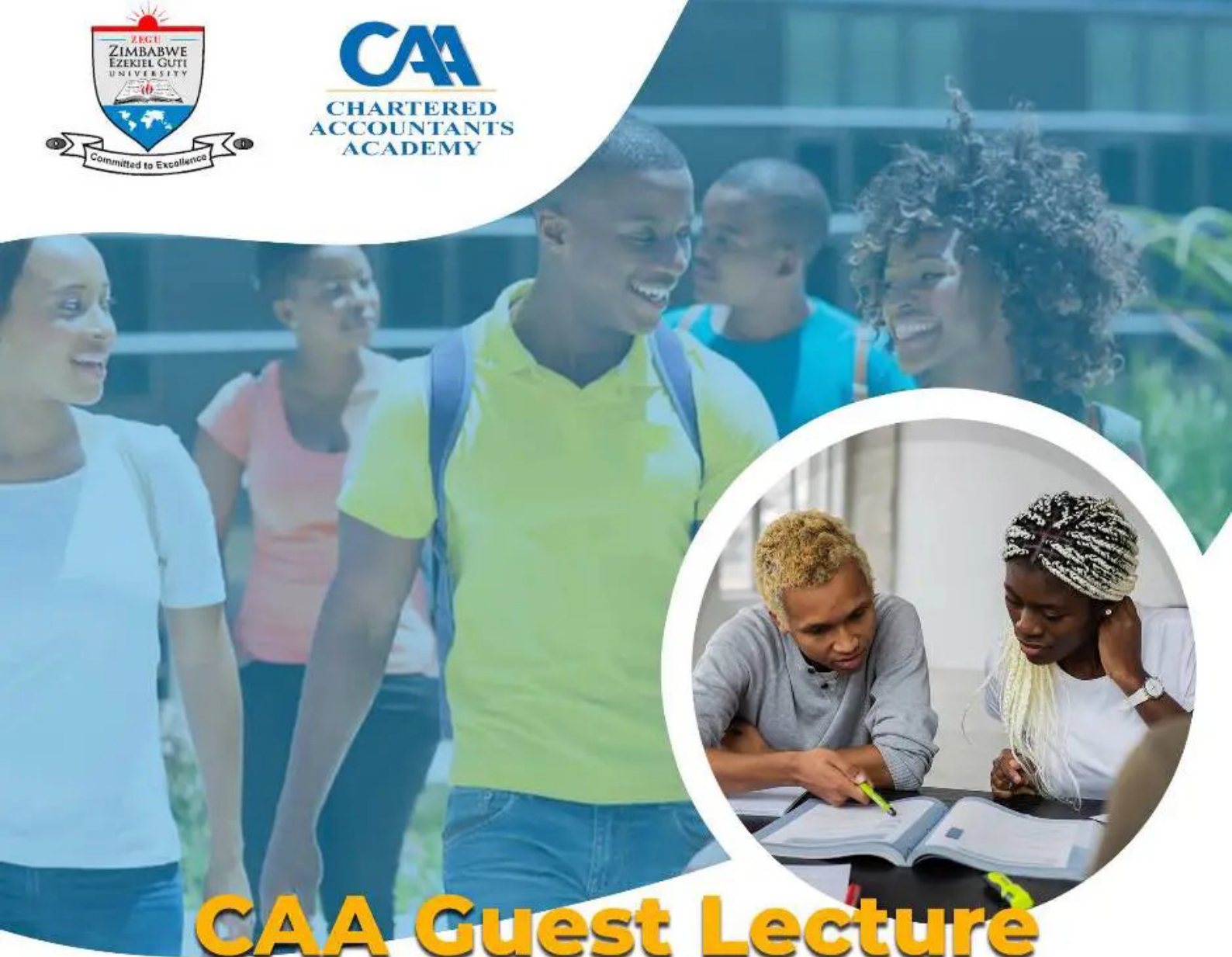


ZEGU's digital space and presence received a significant boost after the institution's Director for Information Communication Technology (ICT), Mr Fanuel Chinyasa, successfully participated in the just-ended Cyber Security Training under the auspices of the Zimbabwe Research and Education Network (Zimren) from the 17th – 20th April 2023, in Nairobi, Kenya.

The training, organised by the UbuntuNet Alliance, an alliance for Eastern and Southern African National Research (NRENs), aims to share intelligence, threats, best practices, and embedding Cyber Security Capacity Building Activities in the region.

Mr Chinyasa and an official from the Harare Institute of Technology (HIT) represented Zimbabwe at the premier occasion. ZEGU and a host of local universities, if not all, are Zimren members. UbuntuNet Alliance was formed in 2005 by 10 NRENs in sub-Saharan Africa.





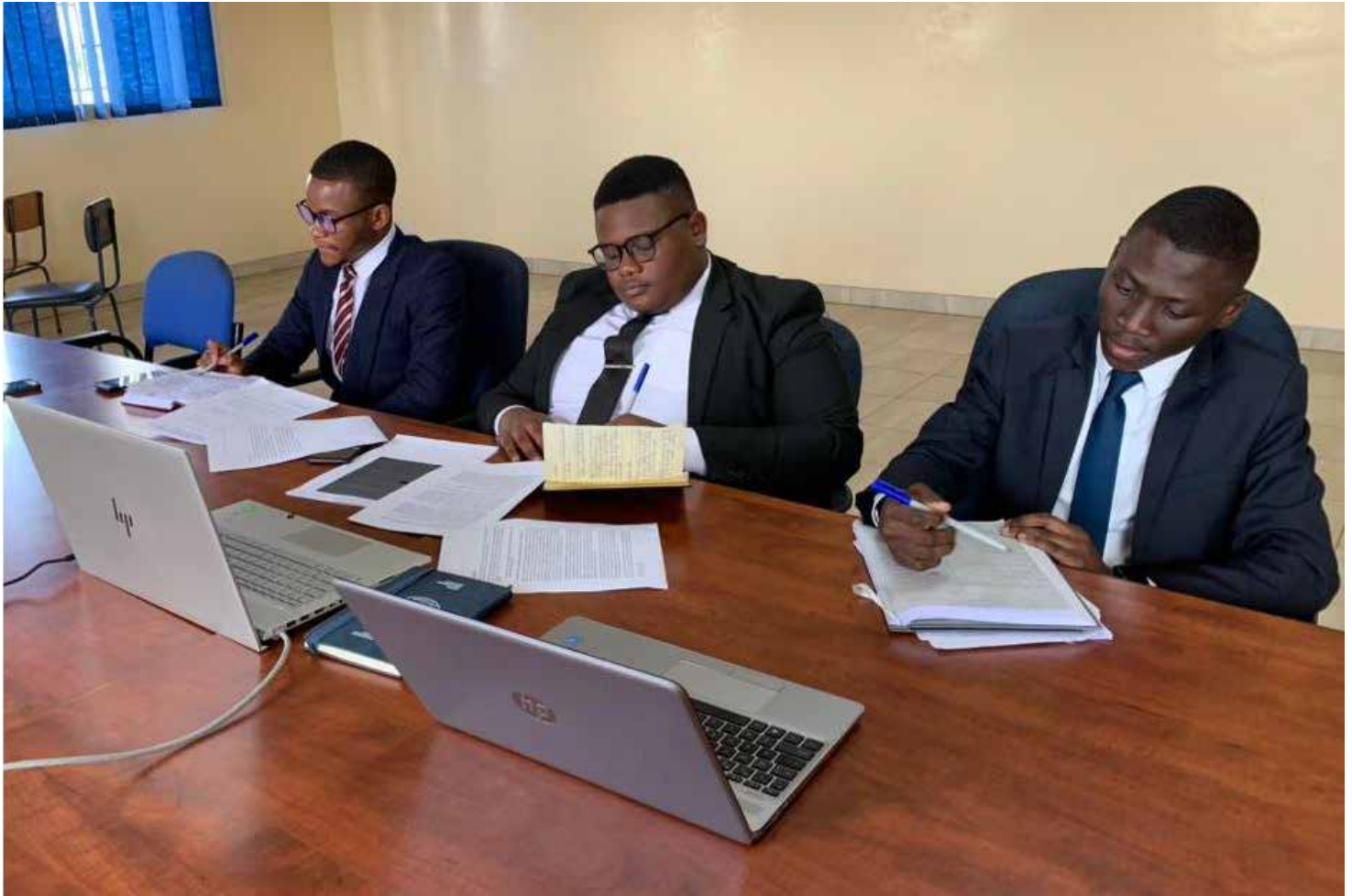

OUT of a pool of over 50 universities (globally) that applied to participate at the 2023 Pax International Moot Court competition held in Belgium, the Zimbabwe Ezekiel Guti University (ZEGU) is proud to have been the only institution to represent Zimbabwe and the African continent, at large, at the European Union (EU) organised event. ZEGU, however, participated online, on the institution's debut at the Pax Moot Court.

The Pax competition commenced in 2012 as an internal moot court activity at Sciences Po Paris initiated by Professor Horaiti Muir Watt and Helene van Lith as part of the SciencesPo team.

It is a specialized moot court competition focused on Transnational Law and Private International Law issues. In this competition, participants will be able to learn and apply firsthand the complexities and nuances of how international Conventions and EU Regulations interact in the context of globalization.

Without pleading on the merits of the case, PAX Moot participants are given cases geared towards private international law questions (jurisdictional, choice of law or recognition and enforcement issues). The 2023 Pax case involved an oil sale, with concerns about the quality of the oil. Furthermore, it

focused on various aspects of civil and commercial law, as well as, insolvency. The moot court oral rounds ran from the 3rd - 5th May 2023. ZEGU was represented by Law students namely, Gama-liel Mabhodheyera, Takudzwanashe Chinyemba and Tadiwa Chipiunza, respectively. The university's Faculty of Law continues to break new ground with tremendous achievements at various moot court competitions across the globe.

The recent exceptional performance at India's KK Luthra Moot Court is another classic example of the faculty's achievements.

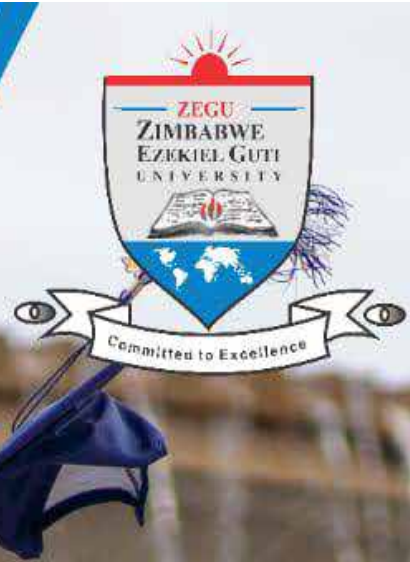
socio-economic challenges faced by twins.

ED recognises ZEGU students

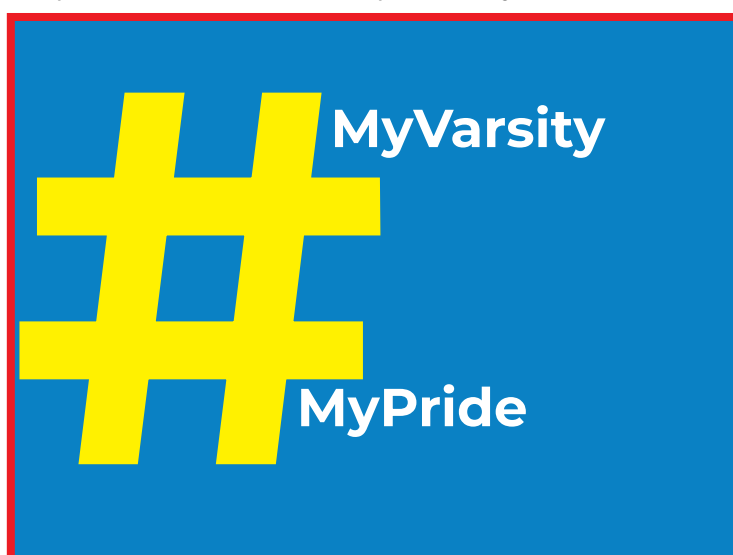

"As an outstanding law student, we invite you to join us for an 8-week Internship," read the Offer.

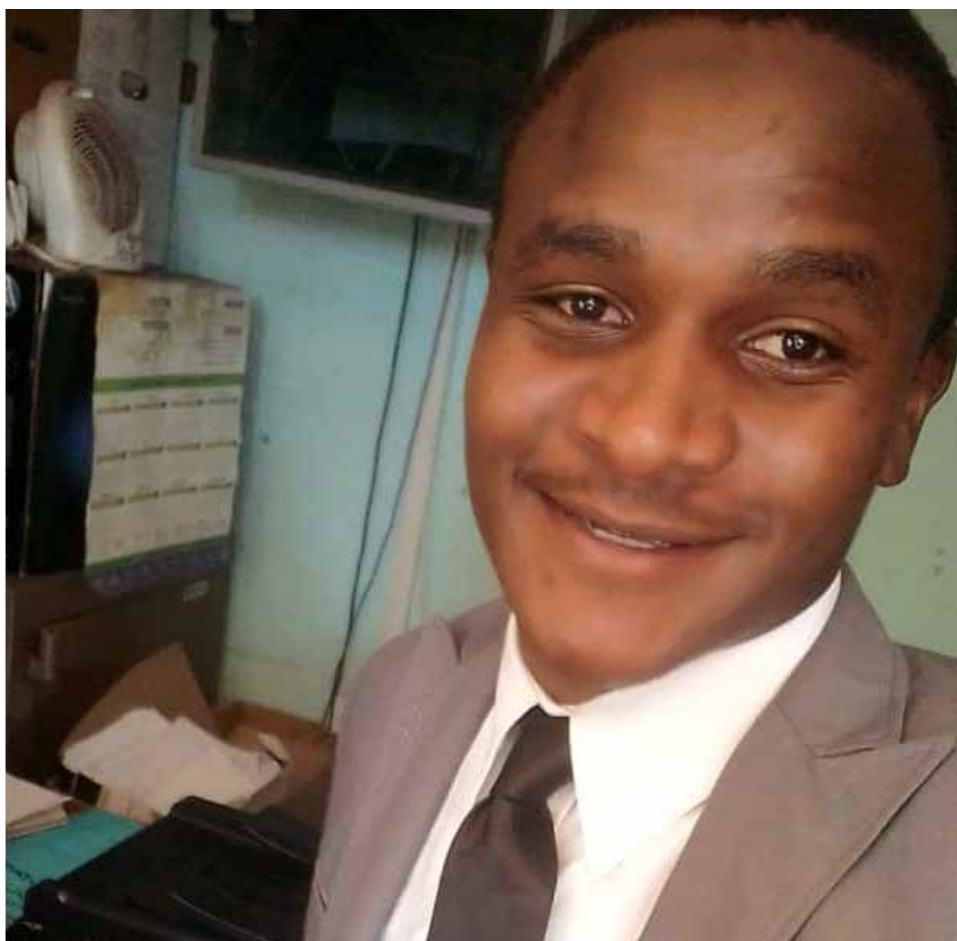

People with Disabilities, Food distribution program, National Aids Council's Community Adolescents Treatment Supporters (CATS) Monitoring, Simuka Upenye Integrated Youth Academy Trust (SIYA) school uniforms distribution programme and Care and Support for Teaching, and Learning (CSTL) Workshop.

Her industrious nature and ability to interact and network with stakeholders saw her profile grow at the Shamva based institution leading to her being recognized and subsequently her drafting into the Population and Housing Census (PHC) 2022 team, as an enumerator, where she was later deployed in Ward 21, Karara Enumerator Area (EA 020).

ZEGU, Magacha union lights up Easter festivities

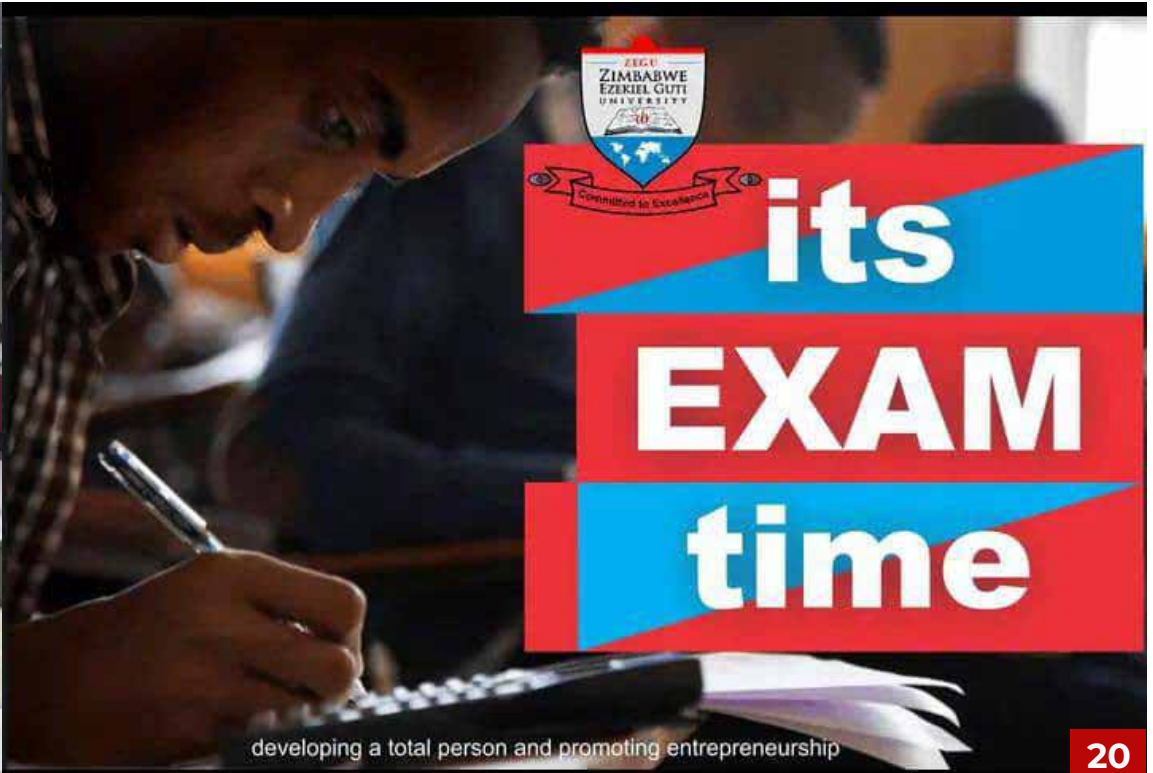

2023 SEMESTER 2 FEES PAYMENT STRUCTURE

Please be advised that at the **Fees Revision Committee Meeting** held on 01 June 2023, the following resolutions regarding the payment of Semester fees for the 2023 Semester 2 were agreed on:-

- (a) Semester fees for **2023 Semesters 2** remains the same at the level that applied to the 2023 Semester 1 fees.
- (b) Students will be required to pay **50% of the total Semester Fees** strictly in **US\$**.
- (c) **University Accommodation Fees** for Conventional Students shall remain **US\$200** strictly paid in **US\$**.
- (d) **University Accommodation** will be availed to students who would have paid **Full Semester Fees** and **Full Accommodation Fees**.
- (e) **Non Resident Students** will be eligible to register after paying 60% of the Semester fees during the **Normal Registration Period**.
- (f) **Late Registration** will attract a **Penalty Fee** as will be determined by the University.
- (g) **Only Registered Students** will be eligible to sit for the **1st Block Examinations**.
- (h) **Examinations Results** for the **1st Block Examinations** shall be accessed by **Fully Paid Up Students**, for the avoidance of doubt, i.e students who would have paid the **Full Semester Fees**.
- (i) **2nd Block Examinations** shall be written by **Fully Paid Up Students Only**.
- (j) **Unregistered Students on Work Related Learning** will not be assessed. **Unassessed Students on Work Related Learning** will automatically fail **Work Related Learning Level**.

All students are therefore urged to acquaint themselves with the **2023 Semester 2 Academic Calendar** and take note of **Registration** and **Other Important Dates** and the provided due dates.
