New dawn beckons for women in academia








HE Zimbabwe Council for Higher Education (ZIMCHE) paid a courtesy call on



HALLELUAH Chirisa like many of her peers has had to expertly play the 'balancing act' as she carefully navigates between her expected social roles as a mother of three (3) and a blossoming professional career that has seen her hold the demanding post of the Zimbabwe Ezekiel Guti University (ZEGU) Research and Innovation Director.

Hailing from arguably the country's best picturesque province, Manicaland, Halleluah, a holder of a BSc Hons (Mathematics and Geography) BUSE 2005, MSc Population Studies (UZ) 2009, is now on the cusp of attaining a PhD in Geography (University of The Free State), a symbol of the hard work she has invested in her pursuit of academic excellence.

Her work experience commenced in earnest as a Temporary Teacher at Garahwa Secondary School and Gaza High School, both in Chipinge District, Manicaland in the early 2000s when she was pursuing her first degree in Education with Bindura University of Science Education (BUSE).

As the horizon broadened, Halleluah proceeded to Rutope High School in Shamva,

Mashonaland Central, where she specialised in teaching Mathematics and Geography, before transferring to Glenview High 1.
