The Zimbabwe Ezekiel Guti University (ZEGU) is proud of Tinashe, who was selected into the final list of 22 students from 14 countries across the globe, at this year's CLS.

Despite failing to get accepted in the 2023 CLS, perseverance paid off as he successfully applied and participated at this year's CLS.

According to Tinashe, his experience in the US will surely have an impact on global food systems from a policy point of view.

"When we arrived in USA, I was in the Agriculture and Soil Health group, and we were (tasked) to identify a problem on a case study farm (Dickinson College Farm). We had to define the problem, data collection, designing systems model, define barriers, present solutions and recommend to policy makers," said Tinashe.

The 2024 CLS ran under the theme: "US – Africa Sustainable Food Systems Through Water-Energy-Food nexus Networking (Sustain Food)".
