REGISTRATION NOTICE: 2026, SEMESTER 1
EXTENSION OF NORMAL REGISTRATION PERIOD


All students (Conventional, Block Release and those on Work Related Learning) are hereby urged to take note of the following information relating to Registration for the 2026, Semester 1 in terms of the 2026 Academic Calendar

- (a) Unregistered students are being advised that **Normal Registration Period has been extended to Tuesday, 31st March 2026.**
- (b) 1st Session Semester Examinations are running from **13th – 17th April 2026.**
- (c) **Only Registered Students** will be allowed to sit for the 1st Session Semester Examinations.
- (d) Students are required to pay at least 60% of the total Semester fees in order to be eligible to register.
- (e) Unregistered students on Work Related Learning **will not** be assessed.
- (f) Students who fail to register within the indicated Registration Timelines should consider themselves as having **deferred** their studies.
- (g) University Accommodation will be accessed by registered students who would have paid **at least 60% of their Semester Fees and Full Accommodation Fee.** The Student Affairs Department will guide on how University Accommodation will be accessed and the students who are eligible to access it.

NB

- All students who Deferred Studies (who failed to register) during the 2025, Semester 2, are urged to properly regularise their Registration within the indicated Registration Timelines to avoid further prejudicing themselves.
- Students are advised not to make payments on the last day of registration as it takes at least 24 hours from the day of payment for the amount to reflect on the portal.
