REGISTRATION NOTICE: 2026, SEMESTER 2

All students (Conventional, Block Release and those on Work Related Learning) are hereby urged to take note of the following information relating to Registration for 2026, Semester 2 in terms of the 2026 Academic Calendar

- (a) Normal Registration is closing on **29th August 2026**.
- (b) Late Registration, which attracts a Late Registration Fee is closing on **11th September 2026**.
- (c) There is **no provision** for Late, Late Registration or Registration in Retrospect.
- (d) 1st Block Semester 2 Examinations are running from **21st – 25th September 2026**.
- (e) **Only Registered Students** will be allowed to sit for the 1st Block Semester 2 Examinations.
- (f) Students are required to pay at least 60% of the total Semester fees in order to be eligible to register.
- (g) Unregistered students on Work Related Learning **will not** be assessed.
- (h) Students who fail to register within the indicated Registration Timelines should consider themselves as having **deferred** their studies.
- (i) University Accommodation will be accessed by students who would have paid **at least 60% of the total Semester Fees and Full Accommodation Fees**. The Student Affairs Department will guide on how University Accommodation will be accessed and the students who are eligible to access it.

NB

- All students who Deferred Studies (who failed to register) during the 2026, Semester 1, are urged to properly regularise their Registration within the indicated Registration Timelines to avoid further prejudicing themselves.
- Students are advised not to make payments on the last day of registration as it takes at least 24 hours from the day of payment for the amount to reflect on the portal.
